IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING REGISTRATION FOR THE
2019-2020 HOCKEY SEASON

The dates for ARHA's online registration for the 2019-2020 season will be:

Monday, March 25th @ 7:00 a.m.– Sunday, April 7th – PRIORITY REGISTRATION for returning players (from the 2018-2019 season ONLY) and their siblings.

Monday, April 8th @ 7:00 a.m. – Registration is open to new players (those who have never played at ARHA or returning players from prior years other than the 2018-2019 season).

PLEASE NOTE:

Your credit card gets charged immediately (it is a point-of-sale system) – you are still NOT registered to ARHA.

If you try to register ahead of when you're eligible (new players registering earlier than April 8th, or former players calling themselves "returning" from previous years) your application(s) will be **automatically deleted!** Full refunds, less a \$25 charge will be issued.

NOTE: THOSE APPLICANTS SEEKING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE LEAGUE MUST CONTACT THE REGISTRAR PRIOR TO GOING ONLINE TO REGISTER AT registrar@avenueroadhockey.com ALL INQUIRIES WILL BE HELD STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Go to the Avenue Road Hockey Association website

(www.avenueroadhockey.com) and follow the link to QuickEnrollment.

On the QuickEnrollment site you have three options. Choose the option that fits your situation. If you have previously registered with QuickEnrollment for hockey or any other sport, your account will be there:

1. You have an account and know your username & password
2. You have an account but can't recall your username & password (QuickEnrollment will send you your information. ARHA does not have Access to this information)
3. You need to create an account as you have never registered with QuickEnrollment before.

Once you open your profile, you can make any changes to your address, phone numbers and email address. **Please remember to use an email address that you check regularly.**

You will then be at the registration pages.

Please read all of Avenue Road Hockey's policies for the 2019-2020 hockey season. You "sign" the waiver, which means you have read, understood & accepted the policies for the 2019-2020 season.

You pay online.

You will receive an automated response from QuickEnrollment advising you that your application has been accepted into their system and that you have been waitlisted. You have simply been accepted into the QuickEnrollment system but not into the ARHA league.

After ARHA accepts your application and registers your child into the league, you will receive a 2nd email from QuickEnrollment, confirming the acceptance of your registration into ARHA for the 2019-2020 season.

You will receive Select May 2019 tryout information shortly (or look for it on our website).

You will receive all season information and mite group placement in SEPTEMBER 2019.
